5. <u>Project Funding Determination(s)</u>

Chair Castle conveyed the Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing Committee had eleven (11) applications to consider for 2023 Greenway Awards. While each applicant submittal was considered a worthy project, the Committee had a difficult task in the allocation of the annual Greenway funding of \$2 million. This Greenway funding is intended to preserve, enhance, and develop the natural, historic, cultural and recreational resources in the Niagara River Greenway, which will benefit residents and visitors throughout Western New York.

The Buffalo and Erie County Greenway Fund Standing Committee announced new awards to the following:

- 1) Buffalo Lighthouse Association, Inc.: Lighthouse Safety and Access Project-\$247,236
- 2) **Buffalo Olmsted Parks Conservancy:** Delaware Park Point of the Meadow Shelter Enhancement Project (construction)-\$225,000
- 3) City of Buffalo: Ralph C. Wilson Jr. Centennial Park-\$400,000 (construction)
- 4) **Buffalo Scholastic Rowing Association, Inc.:** Inclusive Rowing on the Buffalo River-\$314,310
- 5) County of Erie: Erie County Greenway Parks-Signage Implementation-\$165,000
- 6) County of Erie: Isle View Enhancement Project (construction)-\$500,000
