5.0 Approval of Meeting Minutes of November 15, 2022 Meeting

Mr. Broderick made a motion, seconded by Ms. Wydysh, to approve the meeting minutes of November 15, 2022. Motion passed.

6.0 Town of Lewiston

6.1 Sanborn Area Historical Society School House Museum Moving – Bill Read, President, SAHS (Approved for funding in the amount of \$130,000 by the Town of Lewiston on November 14, 2022; Consultation with NRGC on January 17, 2023)

Elaine Timm stated that the Sanborn Area Historical Society (SAHS) is requesting 130,000 from the Greenway funds to move the school house museum at 2822 Niagara Street in Sanborn to the Sanborn Lewiston Farm Museum Complex at 2660 Saunders Settlement Road, Rte 31, Sanborn in the Town of Lewiston. The Town of Lewiston Board has approved using \$130,000 of funding for the school house project. The remaining \$150,000 of the \$280,000 school house project will come from donations and other sources. The cost of planning, acquisition and administration will be paid for by the SAHS. Our existing procedures and budget process will be used to operate and maintain the school house. Ms. Timm explained that they are an all-volunteer organization with over 500 members. The inkind volunteer services have worked well with the SAHS on previous projects funded by the Greenway. For all their Greenway projects they have set up a Greenway & Wine Trail display card rack and incorporated the Greenway logo on their museum sign by the road.

6.0 Town of Lewiston

6.1 Sanborn Area Historical Society School House Museum Moving

Ms. Timm also provided background on the history of the school house and their justification for moving the building, which is included in the proposal that will be attached hereto and made a part hereof these minutes.

Chairperson Wallace confirmed that the SAHS will be seeking other funding and that the Greenway funding is contingent on the SAHS receiving other funding. Ms. Timm stated that that is correct, they have already received some donations and they will be applying for other grants.

Mr. Widger stated that the project meets all procedural requirements.

Ms Wydysh made a motion to approve the funding of the Sanborn Historical Society School House Museum Moving project with the understanding that those funds will be released upon the SAHS procuring the remaining funding from other sources. Mr. Casseri seconded the motion.
